- No duplicate entries are permitted in a category within a given class.
- Any article which has previously won an award at the Preble County Fair in the past five years will not be eligible for re-entry.
- All items to be exhibited must be clean.
- All entries must be at least 50 years of age.
- All items must be securely tagged and identified.
- When presenting exhibit items to the person in charge, have entry sheet as prepared with tags. This will be used to check in receipt of items. When retrieving items, at close of exhibits, present entry sheet so that such items can be checked out.
- Any exhibitor removing his exhibit before the published time will not be permitted to make entries the following year, and shall forfeit all earned premiums.
- The exhibitor assumes responsibility for any loss or damage due to fire, theft, or other causes.
- Preble County Agricultural Society, Fair Board, and Preble County Commissioners are not responsible for persons, items, equipment or accidents on grounds.
