**Rules and Regulations**

1. *Open class entry fee is \$10 per head; any extra stall is \$10*
2. Exhibitor may have one fan per three head of cattle. Barn is well cooled. Fans must be hung. No fans on floor.
3. All breed cattle must have registration papers.
4. Tampering and/or misrepresentation. See 2011 Tampering Exhibitions Rule in front of book. No paint or pumping.
5. No show boxes in aisles running North & South

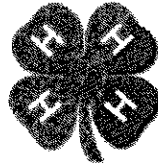
