Entries close at 4 p.m., Saturday June 28, 2008. Stock must be on the grounds at 11 a.m., Saturday, July 26, 2008. Judging will be at 8 a.m., Tuesday, July 29, 2008, with market lambs showing at 8 a.m. Stock will be released at 6 p.m., Tuesday, July 29, 2008 except for Junior Fair owned livestock, which must stay until 4:00p.m., Friday, August 1, 2008.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Any exhibitor removing his exhibit before release time will not be permitted to make entries of any kind next year.

Pen rent is \$4.00 per pen and entry fee is \$4.00 per head. All entry fees and stall rent must be paid at the time the entry is made.

All competitors for premiums must be members of the Society or holders of exhibitors' tickets except Preble County Junior Fair members exhibiting only Junior Fair projects.

The ages of sheep are to be reconciled according to association rules of all the breeds.

All entries from flocks known to have been affected with or exposed to any contagious or infectious disease within the past year shall be accompanied by a certificate signed by a regularly employed state or federal veterinarian.

The management further reserves the right to take any additional measures prior to assigning entries to pens or during the Fair that may be deemed necessary to protect the health of the sheep shown at the Fair.

NO MUZZLES ARE ALLOWED

All lambs must have lamb teeth to show in lamb class. Market lambs will be weighed on Saturday immediately after 4-H lambs.

Exhibitors in this department are limited to two entries in any one class except only one entry may be shown in 3,5,7 and 12.

All sheep must be shown to receive premiums.

All entries must be made in the name of the actual owner of the animal.

All exhibitors must be prepared to show certification of registration if called for. Failure forfeits the right to show or receive an award.

The Preble County Agricultural Society, Fairboard and Preble County Commissioners are not responsible for persons, animals, equipment or accidents on grounds.

Anyone needing either a late arrival or an early release for The Ohio State Fair will indicate this on their entry form.
